Death Investigation – Update #2

Palm Beach Gardens, Florida – The Palm Beach Gardens Police Department extends our condolences to the family of Ryan Rogers. Our police department has been working non-stop to obtain answers into Ryan’s death. Currently, our investigators are following up on the many tips that the public has provided.

We now know that Ryan Rogers’ death was not an accident, but a deliberate act. There is someone in this community that has information that can assist us in identifying the person or people responsible, and bring answers to his family. Investigators are particularly interested in witnesses who were in the area of Central Boulevard and Interstate 95 during the evening of Monday, November 15th, between the hours of 6:30 pm and 9:00 pm. If you were in the area and witnessed something out of the ordinary, we need you to contact us. We are also asking persons with a dash camera in your vehicle who were traveling through the area to call our investigators. No amount of information is too small.

The Palm Beach Gardens Police Department is dedicated to solving Ryan’s death and maintaining a safe city, but we need the public’s help. We want to be clear that we sympathize with our community’s concerns about the safety of our children, and our officers have increased patrols in the community. While the police department investigates this incident, parents should take any precautions they feel are appropriate. Parents should also talk to their children to see if they knew Ryan or heard something about his death that police need to know. Anyone who witnesses a suspicious person or activity should immediately call 561-799-4445 or 9-1-1.

The Palm Beach County Crime Stoppers is now accepting anonymous tips at 800-458-8477. You do not have to provide your name and may be eligible for a reward. A reward of \$8,000 is being offered with the Palm Beach Gardens Police and Fire Rescue Foundation contributing an additional \$5,000 toward the initial reward offered by Crime Stoppers.
