### 90-DAY NOTICE OF INCREASES TO IMPACT FEES

**PURSUANT TO ORDINANCE 5, 2023, THE FOLLOWING IMPACT FEES WILL BE INCREASED: PARKS AND RECREATION, FIRE PROTECTION/EMS, POLICE PROTECTION, AND PUBLIC FACILITIES. THE SUBJECT INCREASES WILL BECOME EFFECTIVE ON APRIL 1, 2024.**

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE AND BE ADVISED** that on December 6, 2023, the City Council of the City of Palm Beach Gardens adopted Ordinance 5, 2023, which updated and revised the City's impact fees for Parks and Recreation, Fire Protection/EMS, Police Protection, and Public Facilities. Pursuant to Section 163.31801, *Florida Statutes*, the City of Palm Beach Gardens does hereby provide notice that the City will increase the impact fees referenced hereinabove with such increase becoming effective on April 1, 2024.

**Impact Fees are assessed and collected at the time of building permit issuance, NOT building permit application. All building permits issued on or after April 1, 2024, will be subject to the impact fees set forth in the new impact fee schedule.**

All documents pertaining to this Ordinance may be inspected by the public in the City Clerk's office (561-799-4122) located at the Municipal Complex Building during regular business hours, Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m., except for holidays.
